
#### **SCIENCE EXHIBITION**






# BANNER MAKING COMPETITION

### BHOPAL BEYOND BOOKS-LEARNING EXPEDITION

















### **PARIKSHA PE CHARCHA** 2024






### **EXPRESSIONS OF GRATITUDE**














## FIELD TRIP- COMMON EFFLUENT TREATMENT PLANT


#### GUEST LECTURE-TEEN HEALTH


## SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT SESSIONS 23-24
