The school is deeply committed to building a strong foundation for young minds. The school has been tirelessly working to provide a nurturing environment that promotes academic, social and emotional growth.



### **Protos - The Pre Primary School**

Our youngest learners occupy this section of the school, where, ideally, children should spend these formative years under the loving guidance of parents and grandparents. The early stages of socialization are most effectively nurtured within the family, where the child first learns about love, trust, and relationships.

However, reality often paints a different picture. Children as young as three, or even younger, are hurried into school, where they are introduced to the alphabet, writing, and computing skills—often in a foreign language—all in the pursuit of securing admission to a prestigious institution. In response to this trend, DPS Surat established its Pre-Primary Wing to offer a more natural and developmentally appropriate pace for early learning. Our Pre-Primary Wing is a place where children are welcomed by smiling, bilingual teachers who genuinely care about their well-being and development both inside and outside the classroom. This helps create a smooth transition between the warmth of home and the novelty of school, forging a partnership between the school, home, and the learner.

At this age, we do not expect children to read, write, or count, even though parents may hope for these skills. While these skills are introduced, our primary focus is on fostering social interactions, encouraging children to learn to work and play together, develop friendships, and build selfconfidence. Through playful exploration, children absorb knowledge without stress, allowing their natural curiosity to flourish.

Thus, the school becomes a microcosm of the outside world, gently introducing children to the social, moral, ethical, and aesthetic values that have shaped human civilization. All academic and co-curricular activities are designed to align with this holistic approach, ensuring that every aspect of the child's development is nurtured. In this supportive environment, children not only learn foundational skills but also develop the emotional resilience and creativity needed for lifelong learning. By placing emphasis on socialization and experiential learning, we create a well-rounded foundation that prepares them for future academic and personal challenges.

### **Deuteros - The Primary School**

The students are prepared to take the next step and understand the fundamentals of knowledge. The curiosity sparked about the world around them is channeled into academic learning through a variety of engaging activities. The focus shifts to developing study skills, with students becoming actively involved in questioning, investigating, experimenting, solving problems, taking responsibility, being creative, and consolidating their learning through projects. Unlike traditional methods, this approach places the learners at the center of the process.

The progress of students in classes 3 and 4 is continually evaluated through a grading system that tracks their efforts, achievements, and the skills they have acquired. Subject comprehension and skills are assessed throughout this process. For students in classes 5 and 6, regular examinations are conducted to familiarize them with the evaluation system required by the CBSE.

Each academic subject emphasizes the foundational skills necessary for learning it, and the weekly timetable is adjusted accordingly. We discourage the practice of relying on tuition or rote learning. Instead, we follow the Learning Partnership framework, where parents provide a supportive home environment and moral encouragement for assignments and experiments. This complements the 'learning by doing' approach in school. Feedback is shared regularly to help students confront challenges, solve problems, and build confidence through these learning experiences. Remedial measures are an integral part of our system, and we strive to avoid any stigma. We believe in each student's potential, and all efforts to improve are celebrated. Children are not labeled as 'brilliant' or 'weak'; rather, both teachers and students are continually working towards personal and collective growth.

To ensure holistic development, we offer a diverse range of co-curricular activities alongside academics.

We believe that learning extends beyond textbooks—life's experiences offer lessons that last a lifetime.

### **Tritos - The Secondary School**

Transitioning from Primary to Secondary Wing is a significant change for middle school students, bringing new faces, opportunities, and challenges. For evaluation, we implement periodic tests, internal assessments, and term examinations, with continuous feedback provided through reports and parent-teacher interactions. This approach ensures that students are consistently learning throughout the year, with remedial support whenever needed. This system is sufficient to prepare students for the Term examinations without subjecting them to unnecessary stress from the outset.

With a balanced emphasis on academics and co-curricular activities, we ensure that every learner strives for a healthy mind in a healthy body. We do not expect all students to achieve top marks, but they are encouraged to do their best in every challenge they face, whether academic or extracurricular. We believe in confident participation over winning, continual learning over competing, and improvement over perfection.

At DPS Surat, we believe in fostering an environment where students are encouraged to explore their potential, embrace challenges, and celebrate personal growth. ### **Central Library**

## **CCTV Surveillance Room**

To ensure safety and security, the school has installed CCTV cameras throughout the Pre-Primary, Primary, Secondary, and Senior Secondary sections, including corridors, classrooms, offices, sports complex, cafeteria, playground, entrances, exits, and the parking lot. These cameras monitor all activity within the school premises. A dedicated CCTV surveillance room, located in the Senior Secondary Block, oversees the monitoring of the entire school.



### **Server Room**

To enhance teaching, learning, and access to information, the school provides internet services, a school intranet system for efficient communication, and hosts several web pages to keep students, teachers and parents updated on school activities. To support these IT needs, the school has a well-equipped server room, managed by IT experts.



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# **Audio Visual Room**

The school has a fully equipped Audio Visual room to supplement theoretical instruction at the Pre-Primary, Primary, Secondary and Senior Secondary level. Students have access to facts in a more interesting manner through presentations. The teachers are able to disseminate knowledge via documentaries, videos and talks of eminent personalities.









### **Computer Lab**

The school is equipped with eight Computer Labs. The Pre-Primary section features iMacs, while the Primary section has three labs, each fully equipped with individual computers running Windows OS. Students have the opportunity to learn, create, and explore under the guidance of skilled teachers, making the learning process effective.

Computer Lab-3 also serves as a language lab for classes 5 and 6, where students' communication skills are developed and nurtured. The Secondary section has two well-equipped labs with Windows OS, and the Senior Secondary section has one lab, also with Windows OS, catering to students who have chosen Computer Science as an elective.

The Computer Labs are staffed by technically qualified faculty who guide students in both communication and technology, ensuring a comprehensive learning experience.






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### **Special Educator Room**

#### Performing Arts Studio (Dance)
